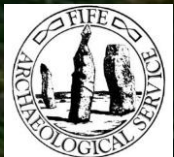

- 1678 ~ Pier “broke down”
- 1685 ~ “A small pier for small vessels”
- 1703 ~ “a long stone pier”
- 1705 ~ Noted by Defoe as 400’ long
- 1712 ~ Pier damaged and rebuilt
- 1722 ~ Pier damaged and repaired
- 1727 ~ Pier entirely “beat down” and the Bents breached in several places blocking the basin with sand
- 1788 ~ “half the pier fell down”
- 1823 ~ “the pier was breached by storm”

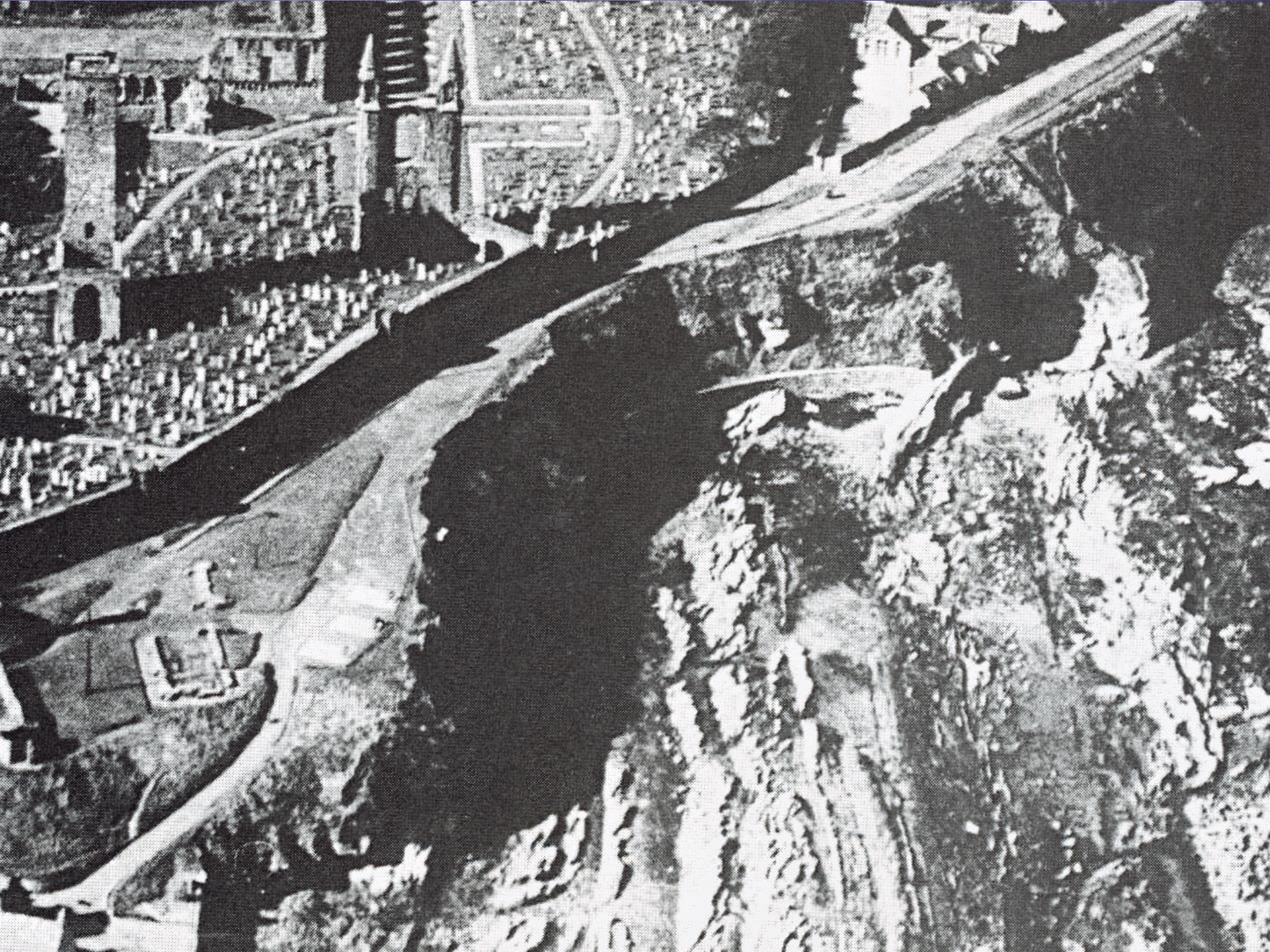


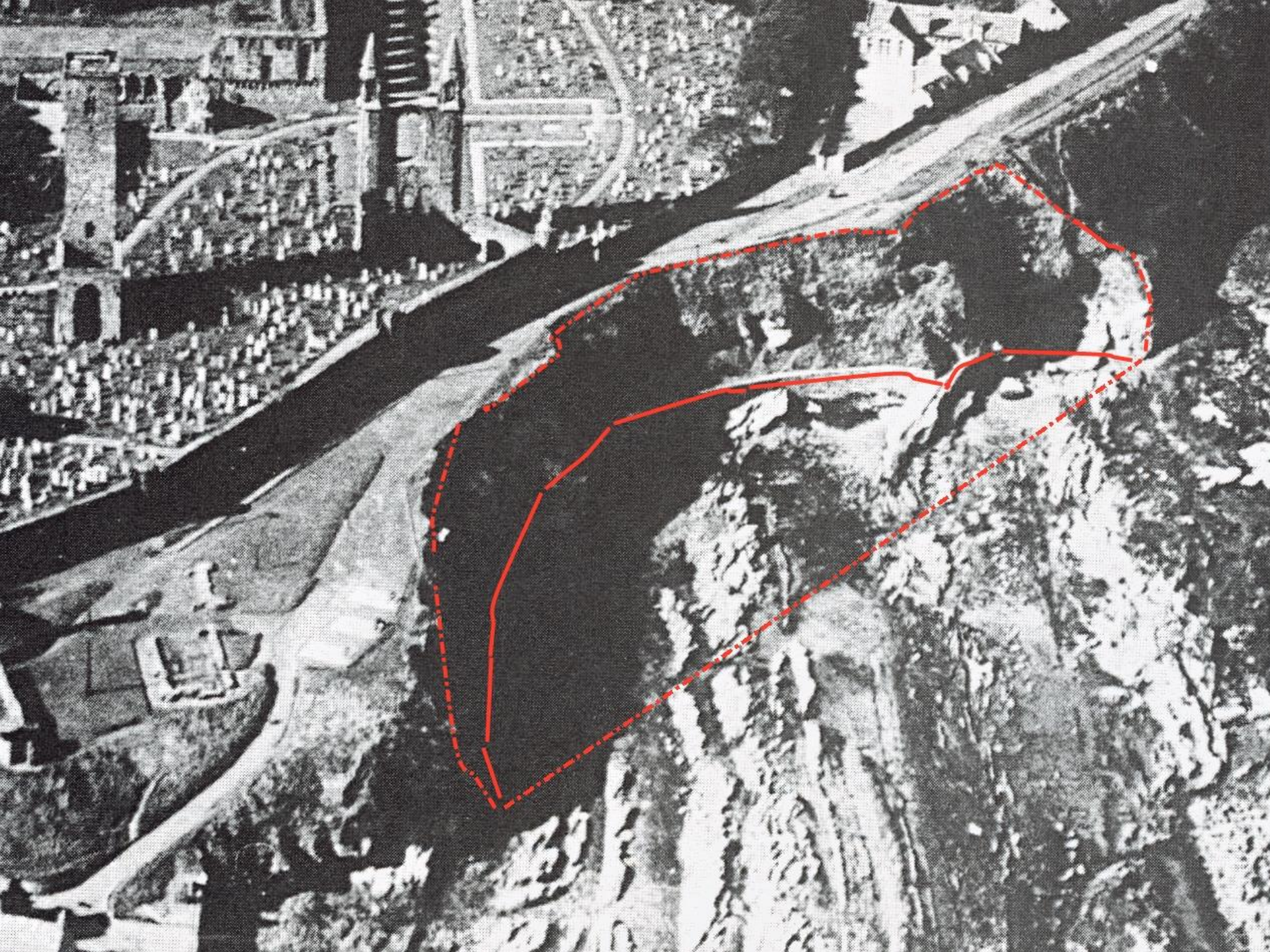
